We have made some recent progress on the repairing of the lodge hall foundation. More jacks are needed to proceed to jack up and put timbers underneath.

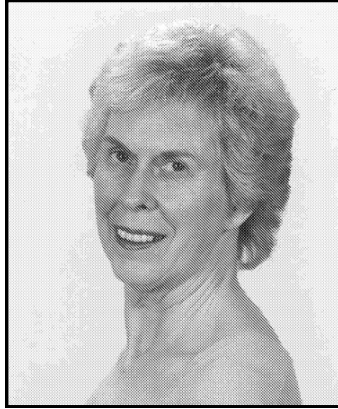

July is here and our sessions are over. The proceedings are being put in the mail as I write this article.

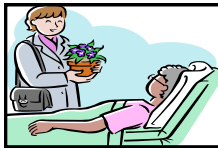

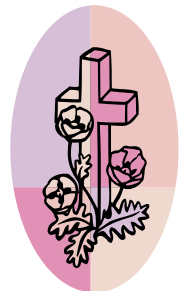
